About the Founder



Shihan Fumio Toyoda was born in Japan on November 8, 1947 and began studying Aikido at the age of 10. After earning his shodan in Aikido at age 17, he was accepted as jyoju (live-in student) at the Ichikukai Dojo in Tokyo, where he committed himself to three years of rigorous training in misogi and zen. During this time he also pursued a law degree at Senshu University. After graduating from Senshu University, Toyoda Shihan lived as uchideshi at Aikido World Headquarters (Aikikai Hombu Dojo), and there began his career as a professional, full-time Aikido instructor. His teaching responsibilities took him to South Korea and Hawaii, where he presented Aikido demonstrations and seminars to instructors and beginners alike. Through these demonstrations and seminars, Toyoda Shihan recognized the growing need for full-time, qualified Aikido instruction and made a personal commitment to spread the art and philosophy of Aikido beyond the shores of his native Japan. Beginning in 1984, Toyoda Shihan began to fulfill this commitment by personally spreading the teachings of Aikido to Europe, Canada and more than 30 states across the U.S. In 1984, Toyoda Shihan founded the *Aikido Association of America* (AAA) to provide a network of support for dojo around the world in order to maintain standards of excellence in Aikido and the application of Aikido philosophy in daily life. Through his diligent work and commitment, Toyoda Shihan dedicated his life to promoting Aikido to its highest level throughout America, and internationally through Aikido Association International.

About the Instructor

Tomasz Krzyzanowski Sensei, Director of Aikido Association International Poland (AAI-Polska), is a direct student of Fumio Toyoda Shihan. Krzyzanowski Sensei had a background in karate and began aikido in 1985. He spent most of his summers in Chicago training with Toyoda Shihan between 1991 and 2000. With Toyoda Shihan's assistance, he founded AAI-Polska in 1996, and currently has 31 affiliated dojo which he visits regularly.

Several AAI-Polska dojocho will be accompanying him on this trip. Krzyzanowski Sensei's home is in Olsztyn, Poland, at Masa Katsu Dojo which he designed himself. Building was completed in early 2006 and the dojo was named and opened by Yasuo Kobayashi Shihan. Krzyzanowski Sensei regularly teaches seminars in Latvia and Lithuania, and has also instructed in Russia, Greece, and Bulgaria. As a student, his aikido travels have taken him to Japan, France, Belgium, the Netherlands, Germany, Sweden, Finland, and the Czech Republic. In addition to traditional aikido instruction, Krzyzanowski Sensei also instructs law enforcement seminars for military police, city police, and security companies.

Toyoda Shihan's influence and dynamic style is very apparent in Krzyzanowski Sensei's aikido. His instruction is a not-to-be missed event.

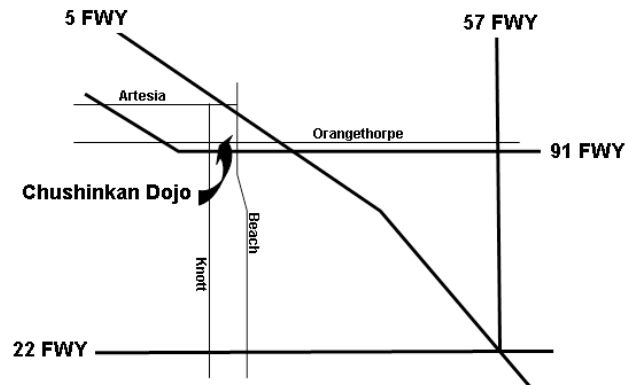
